

Program Fee:

TBA. Includes the cost of instruction, 12-15 credits of UF tuition, cultural activities and events, weeklong capstone trip (location to be determined), 4 full day excursions, museum tours, guest speakers, numerous group meals and receptions, orientation, transportation in Paris, and CISI medical coverage.



Housing Fees:



Estimated rent and electricity for lodging is approximately 400-800 euros/month. Students have a variety of housing options including shared apartments, foyers, rooms, and home stays. Housing arrangements are made by *Paris Academic Rentals*.
