## *Medieval and Early Modern Studies (MEMS) in Germany*



The UF MEMS-Mannheim program in Germany offers students the opportunity to explore the rich political, literary, and artistic history of the Holy Roman Empire, and and at the same time to complete GER 2200 (Intermediate German) or GER 1122 (The final course of the beginning sequence). The city of Mannheim, located in the Rhine river valley in the historic Palatinate, is close to the Roman limes, the former imperial cities of Worms, Speyer, and Strasbourg, and provides easy access to a wealth of cultural resources that will be explored in program field trips.

## HIGHLIGHTS

- Intermediate German course options for students who wish to improve their German language skills
- Field trips include:
  - the Imperial Building and Ruins in Trier
  - the Carolingian Royal Hall and the Cloister museum in Lorsch
  - the Imperial Cathedral in Speyer
  - the Nibelungen, Luther sites, and the medieval Jewish cemetery in Worms
  - the weekend at the Empire of the Hapsburgs in Vienna

## COURSE OFFERINGS

**MEM 3350:** Explorations of the Holy Roman Empire

**GER 1122:** Third Semester Beginning German

**GER 2200:** Intermediate German (online course)

GER 2200 satisfies the MEMS language requirement and qualifies students to do advanced work in German Studies.

**Eligibility:** Students in good standing who have completed the first semester of their freshman year, have earned a 2.5 GPA on 4.0 scale, and are at least 18 years of age.

**Students from other universities and community colleges are welcome to apply.**

## **Explorations in the Holy Roman Empire:**

### **The MEMS-Mannheim Program**

The MEMS-Mannheim program provides students with the opportunity to inform themselves about the rich cultural history of the Holy Roman Empire by means of MEMS coursework in English and frequent weekly fieldtrips to sites of great historical importance in the Middle Ages, including cathedrals, castles, residential palaces, and monasteries.

### **Housing**

Students will be housed in double rooms in student dormitories of the University of Mannheim. Application deadline is March 1, 2007. The space in this program is limited and applications are considered on a space-available basis, so please apply early.

### **Financial Aid**

University of Florida students needing financial aid should apply through UF Student Financial Affairs (SFA). Non-UF students needing financial aid must apply to their home institutions.

### **Scholarships**

As this is a UF program, credits taken can satisfy major, minor, and university requirements with prior approval. UF GPA credit will be granted for courses taken with UF faculty.

### **FEES DUE UPON APPLICATION:**

A \$250 deposit toward the total cost of the program is required at the time of application, of which \$50 is non-refundable. The remaining fees are due no later than 30 days prior to departure.

Students receiving financial aid may defer payment for up to 60 days after departure.

#### ***Not Included in the program fees:***

Round-trip airfare, additional personal travel and personal expenses.
