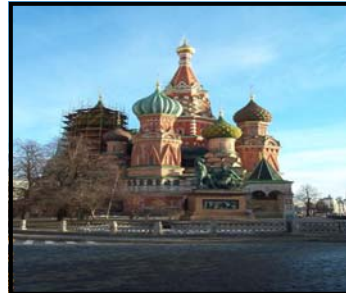


UF in Moscow, Russia

The UF in Moscow program offers students an opportunity to earn eight credits at Russian State University for the Humanities. Study in Moscow provides students with an opportunity to improve their oral, listening, and reading proficiency in Russian language and area studies, and offers deep immersion into Russian society.

Fee includes: Eight credits of tuition, lodging in a dormitory room, Moscow airport pick-up, local excursions, three day trip to St. Petersburg, two-day trip to the ancient Russian cities of Suzdal and Vladimir, two-day trip to Leo Tolstoy's estate in Yasnaya Polyana, study material, language and cultural instruction, and MEDEX emergency assistance insurance.

Round-trip airfare is not included.

UF in Moscow

Moscow is the biggest political, industrial, scientific, and cultural center of Russia. Founded in 1147, the city has a current population of over ten million. Summer study takes place at one of the best institutions of higher learning in Russia, the famous Russian State University for the Humanities (www.rggu.com). Students have an opportunity to take part in a fascinating program of sightseeing, enjoy dozens of theaters, concert halls, and museums, while witnessing the ongoing changes in the political and economic life of Russia.

Housing

Students live in rooms for two persons in the Russian State University for the Humanities dormitory. Meals are available in cafeterias and restaurants near the campus.

Financial Aid

University of Florida students needing financial aid should apply through UF Student Financial Affairs (SFA). Non-UF students needing financial aid must apply to their home institutions.

Scholarships

The deadline for application for summer scholarships administered by the UF International Center is **February 1, 2007**. Application forms available at the website www.abroad.ufic.ufl.edu and at the International Center in 123 Grinter Hall.

Partial scholarships for UF students are available on a competitive basis through the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the Honors program, as well as the International Center.

Academic Credits

As the UF in Moscow is a UF sponsored program, credits from courses taken can satisfy major, minor, elective, and university requirements with prior approval. Transfer credit will be earned with courses offered from Russian State University for the Humanities.

FEES DUE UPON APPLICATION:

A \$250 deposit toward the total cost of the program is required at the time of application, of which \$50 is non-refundable. The remaining fees are due no later than 30 days prior to departure.

Students receiving financial aid may defer payment for up to 60 days after departure.

Not Included in the program fees:

Round-trip airfare, meals, local transportation, additional personal travel and personal expenses.

Major medical health insurance coverage while outside of the United States is **MANDATORY** for all UF students. Verification of major medical health insurance coverage which meets UF standards is required.
