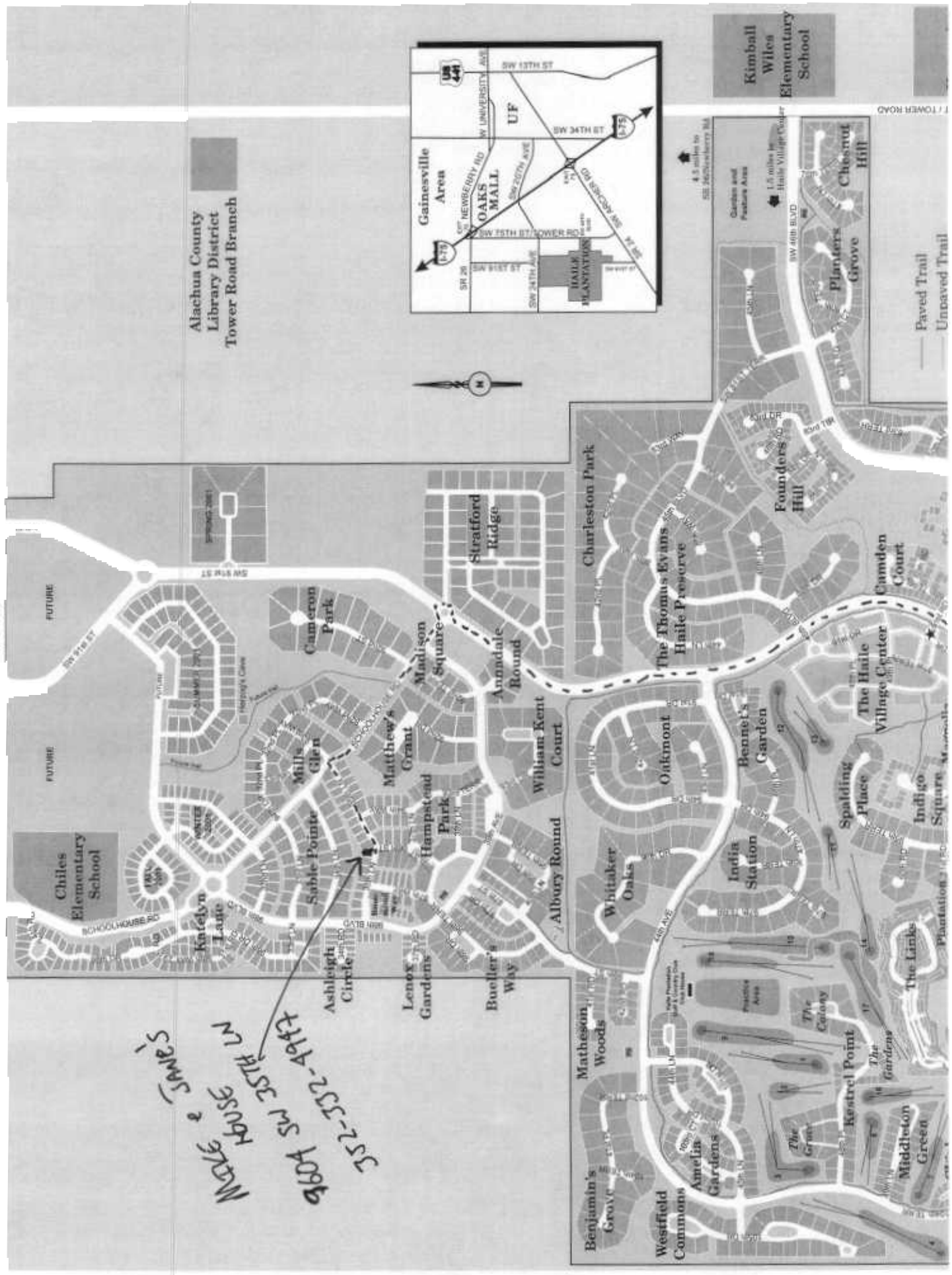
# Haile Plantation®
