Objectives:

- The *Yookoso* series is designed under the communicative approach to learning language. All activities, whether focusing on *comprehension* (hearing, reading), or *production* (speaking, writing), are designed to enable you "to use Japanese in real-life situations for different communicative purposes" (Preface, xiv). The specific purposes explored this term are the body and health, life and careers, communication and media, and nature and culture. One-hundred sixteen new kanji will also be learned.
- Additional materials will be added to the curriculum. We will start out viewing a few commercials. We'll also use a series of 20-minute videos on facets of life in Japan today to examine aspects of Japanese culture, both physical and behavioral. We will (1) translate selected passages with the aid of dictionaries, and (2) transcribe, or provide furigana, for selected digital clips from the films. The digital clips will be viewed in the Tandberg lab in 1317 Turlington, where we will meet every other Friday. You can also visit the lab at other times, to view materials on your own.
- We might be able to use an interactive conversational program called "Language Partner," which was created by faculty in the Technical Japanese Program at the University of Washington. This program lets you record your voice while you respond to an onscreen "partner." It is designed to enhance listening and speaking abilities.
- Suggestions welcome: visuals, www, translating. What would you like to do? Let me know.

Requirements and Grading:

In order to be an effective language learner and do well in this course, you need to plan on studying Japanese at least two hours each day. The daily schedule is designed so that you prepare the materials indicated for a given date the day/night before that class meets.

- Homework is to be prepared ahead of time, corrected in class, and turned in to the instructor on the date it appears in the syllabus. Be prepared to ask questions in class regarding points of difficulty in the homeworks. No late homeworks will be accepted.
- Attendance is mandatory, and will be recorded at each class session.
- No make-up quizzes or tests will be given for any reason except documented emergency. The lowest quiz score may be dropped.
- If you have questions, feel free to ask in class or to visit the instructor during office hours.
